

Summer Shootout Tournament Guidelines

General National High School Federation Rules Apply

Please note the following:

1. Each game is twenty minutes running clock. The clock will stop during last two minutes of second half. If a team is up by 20 points or more, the clock will continue to run.
2. Each team is allowed two thirty-second time-outs per half. No carry over from first half.
3. Each team is to be coached by an adult and not a player.
4. Each team is required to fill in stat sheets 5 minutes prior to start of their game and any player that is not listed on stat sheet that comes into the game will result in technical. Opposing team will automatically be awarded two points.
5. Any altercation resulting in a technical will result in automatic two points for opposing team. Unsportsmanlike player, coach, or parent may be dismissed from the tournament.
6. Half-time is three-minutes.
7. Ten-second backcourt violation will be in effect due to no shot clock.
8. Players will be allowed five fouls.
9. In case of overtime, two minutes will be allowed for first overtime, one minute for second, and sudden death for the third overtime. One 30-second time-out in overtime and no time-outs carry over if not used in regulation or previous overtime period.
10. The top 12 teams will play on Sunday. The top four teams will have a bye in championship bracket on Sunday. Since every team will have played their minimum amount of games (5 varsity, 4 jv) it is single elimination. The division leaders will be the first three seeds while the next top record would be the fourth seed. In case of a tie of record for that fourth seed, head to head will determine the higher seed. If they didn't play each other then points allowed will be the deciding factor. The remaining eight seeds will be determined based on:
 - Overall Pool Record
 - Head to Head
 - Points allowed
 - Points scored
 - Coin Flip
11. Concession stands will be open at each gym. Please do not bring any food or drink besides water on gym floor.

Summer Shootout 3 Point Contest Rules

Each team is allowed one representative to compete. This would provide us with 18 contestants. Each contestant will shoot 20 three pointers (4 from 5 different spots).

The top 8 contestants will move on to the second round. Each of the 8 contestants will also shoot 20 three pointers from the 5 different spots. The top 4 contestants will move on to the third round.

Round three will have the top four contestants competing for the final two competitors. The final round will have the final two contestants competing.

Directions to Gyms for Summer Shootout

To Meadowdale High School:

From I-5 North-Take exit 183, the 164th St exit and take a right off of the exit. Head east on 164th and it will eventually curve to an intersection that leads you to 168th St. Take a right onto 168th St. head east past Highway 99. You will see the school on the left after you pass the main intersection of 52nd Ave. The address is 6002 168th St. SW, Lynnwood, WA 98037.

From I-5 South-Take exit 181a, the 44th Ave. exit. Take a left off of the exit onto 44th Ave. Head north until you reach 168th St. and take a left. Go past Highway 99 and also 52nd Ave. and you will see the school on your left. The address is 6002 168th St. SW, Lynnwood, WA 98037.

From Edmonds Woodway High School

Take a left out of the gym parking lot onto 76th Ave. Keep straight until you reach the stop sign at Perrinville Village. Take a right onto Olympic View Dr. Take a right when you get to 168th St. The school will be on the right.

From Lynnwood High School-Take a right out of the main entrance onto 184th St. Take a left onto 36th Ave. Take a right onto 188th St. Take a right onto 44th Ave. Take a left onto 168th St. School will be on your left.

To Edmonds Woodway High School:

From I-5 South- exit 181a, the 44th Ave. exit. Take a left off of the exit onto 44th Ave. Take a left onto 196th St. and head west to 76th Ave. Take a left onto 76th Ave. and just after the 212th St. intersection is the gym parking lot on the right.

From I-5 North- from I-5 North-Take exit 183, the 164th St exit and take a right off of the exit. Head east on 164th and it will eventually curve to an intersection that leads you to 168th St. Take a right onto 168th St. Take a left onto Highway 99. Take a right onto 212th St. Take a left at 76th and make a right at the first entrance to the school. The gym is on the right.

From Meadowdale High School-Take a left out of the gym parking lot onto 168th St. SW. Take a left at first light that would put you on Olympic View Dr. Take a left at 76th Ave. at the bottom of the hill in Perrinville Village. Go past the intersection of 212th St. while passing the school on the right. Take the first entrance on the right. The gym is right next to the parking lot.

From Lynnwood High School-Take a right out of the main entrance onto 184th St. Take a left at 36th Ave. Take a right onto 188th St. Take a left onto Highway 99. Take a right onto 212th. School will be on corner of 212th and 76th Ave.

To Lynnwood High School

From I-5 South-Take Exit 181a (44th. Ave) Take a left at light onto 44th Ave. Head north on 44th to 188th St. Take a right onto 188th St. Take a left onto 36th Ave. Take a right onto 184th St. The school will be on your left.

From I-5 North-Take Exit 183. Take a right onto 164th St. Take a left onto Alderwood Mall Parkway. You can enter the back entrance near 182nd St. Or head to 184th St. and take a right. The school will be on your right.

From Meadowdale High School-Take a right out of the Meadowdale parking lot onto 168th St. Take a right onto 44th Ave. Take a left at 188th St. Take a left onto 36th Ave. Take a right onto 184th St. School is on the left.

From Edmonds Woodway High School-Take a left out of the gym parking lot. Take a right onto 212th Ave. Take a left onto Highway 99. Take a right onto 188th St. Take a left onto 36th Ave. Take a right onto 184th St. School will be on your left.
